DOCG BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO

Brunello di Montalcino is not just a territory of a wine with a denomination of origin, but is a product known throughout the world for the supreme quality of Italian wine.

In the 19th century the name Brunello was not referred to a wine but to a variety of grapes grown in the territory of Montalcino. Indeed, the Sangiovese grosso was called Brunello by local producers, for the dark color of its berries. The first vintage of Brunello di Montalcino is dated 1863, produced by Ferruccio Biondi Santi. He understood immediately that it was a wine of high quality, and that it would give the amazing results with a long aging.

Initially, the wine of Biondi Santi aroused doubts among the other winemakers, as it was usually drunk "young", but with time they had to acknowledge that he had been right, and now there are more than 200 producers of Brunello di Montalcino.

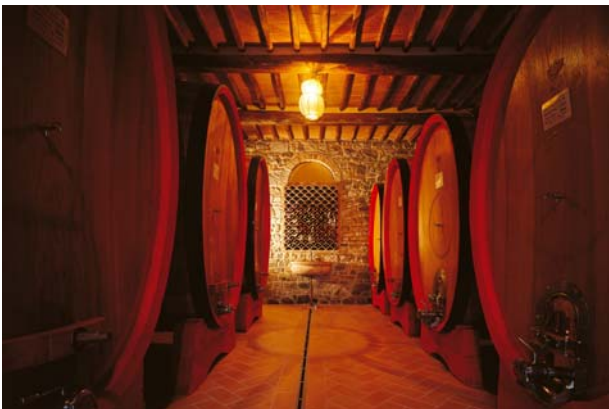
